Arizona Resident Undergraduate Tuition+ Fees Structure 2022–2023

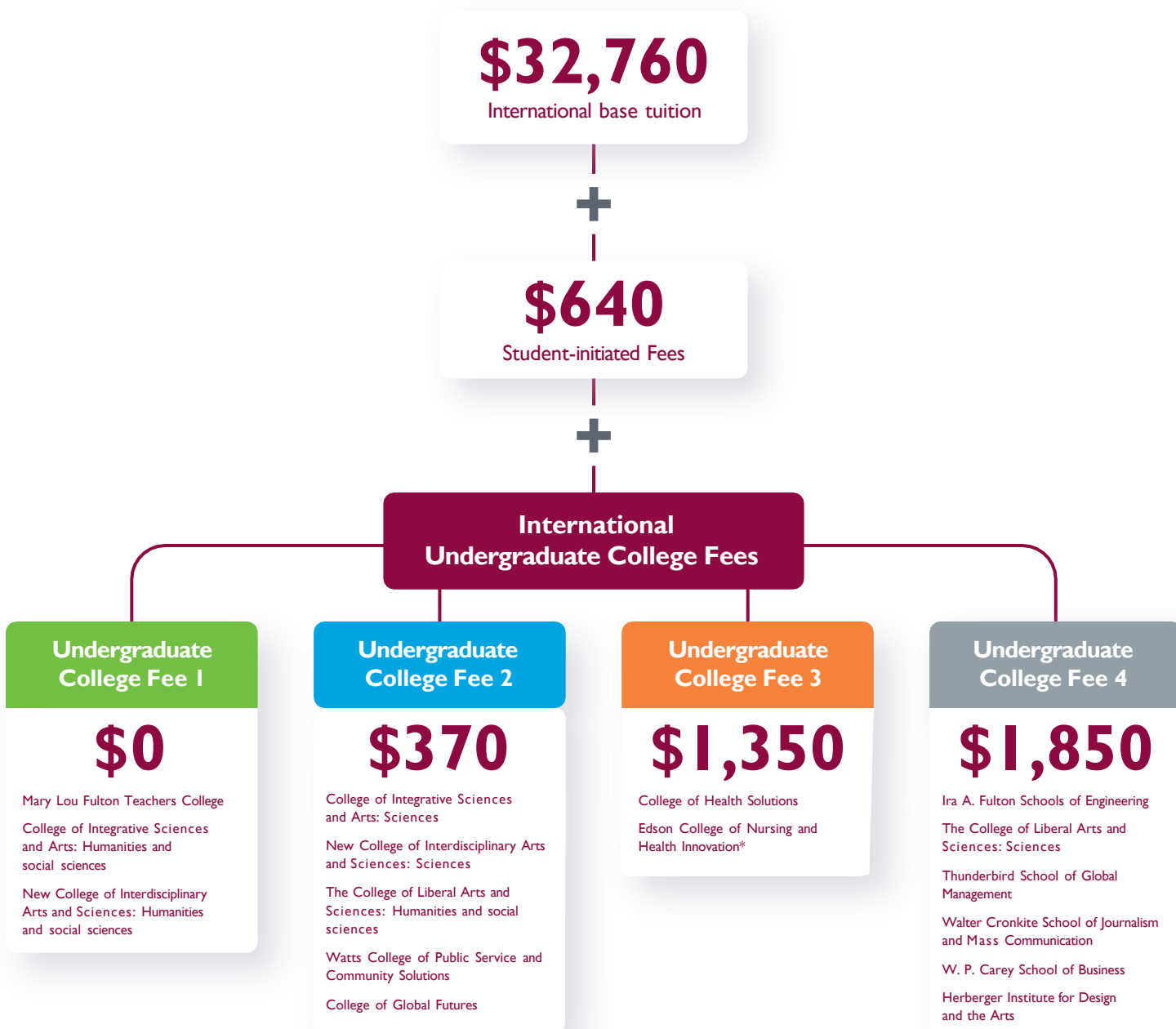


Nonresident Undergraduate Tuition+ Fees Structure 2022–2023
