Response

- UTO is currently working on upgrading security, including the following:
 - stronger passwords
 - encrypting data on laptops and workstations
 - masking information (so your SS number shows up as XXX-XX-5555)
 - 2-step verification for viewing certain information
 - re-enter password
 - answer secret question
