- 1. Review the Non Tenure Track promotional advancement opportunities.
 - a. Outcome: Senate Motion # 2015-53, Approved by Senate on February 23, 2015 influencing subsequent administrative action to make promotional advancement guidelines clearer for instructional faculty members. The following administrative protocol was released on February 24, 2015 addressing this issue.
- 2. Reviewed proposed new policy language relating to ACD 607 and faculty members request for Emeritus status.
 - a. Outcome: Reviewed and approved language found in Senate motion 2015-67.
