The University Senate saw the full range of activities in the month of October. Our committees had at least one meeting and began deliberations on recommendations concerning, for example, Non Tenure Eligible faculty, long term faculty compensation strategy, Open Access implementation, and campus lighting and safety infrastructure. The Online Education Task Force met to shape an agenda around this critical growth area. We are also participating in initiatives from the Provost's office. The Provost's Academic Integrity Task Force will be taking up both information needs and implementation issues in early November with a

view toward a university-wide database later this academic year. A General Education evaluation is likely given the Regents' interest in this area, and we will coordinate this with the annual Regents' breakfast in February.

Feedback on any of these concerns, or others, is very welcome and thank you for your continued support of shared governance.
